

CONDITIONS FOR ACCEPTANCE

Technically non-combustible residual

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Allowed:

Technically non-combustible residual waste is residual waste that is combustible, but due to its physical properties cannot be processed in an incinerator:

For example:

- Residual waste with maximum dimensions in excess of: Board: 1m x 1m x 0.1 m; Cube: 0.5m x 0.5m x 0.5m
- Strings, threads, ribbons, rolls, etc.
- Powdery, dusty products

Prohibited:

- Waste must be in solid form
- No free fluid
- PVC
- Substances that cause an exothermic reaction or hot or warm waste (BBQ ashes, etc.)
- No railway sleepers, tree stumps, concrete blocks (with rebars) or polyester tanks
- No animal by-products from CAT. 1, 2 or 3

The following waste must be collected separately and must not therefore be added to the residual waste: worden gevoegd:

- Small Hazardous Waste of similar business origin
- Glass waste
- Paper and cardboard waste
- Used vegetable or animal oils or fats
- Green waste
- Textile waste
- Discarded electrical and electronic equipment
- Waste tyres
- Rubble
- Used oil
- Hazardous waste (including empty packaging bearing the hazard symbol)
- Asbestos-containing waste
- Discarded appliances and containers that contain ozone-depleting substances or fluorinated greenhouse gases
- Waste agricultural films
- Discarded batteries and accumulators
- Wood waste
- Metal waste
- PMD waste
- Recyclable rigid plastics
- Expanded polystyrene (EPS, Styropor)
- Films

In case of non-conformity, the collector reserves the right to reject the load in question and/or to pass on any extra costs of collection and processing.
