

CONDITIONS FOR ACCEPTANCE

Soft packaged foodstuffs & swill in 240-litre roller bin

DESCRIPTION

Only soft packaged foodstuffs and organic kitchen waste such as leftover fruit, vegetables, meat, fish, dairy, bread and pastries, sauces and soups. This applies to both organic kitchen waste from food preparation and food leftovers from tables.

Fill your container no more than 3/4 full. Only then can we tip it and empty it safely without any problems.

CONDITIONS

Allowed:

- Former foodstuffs with soft packaging
- CAT 3 animal by-products falling under Article 10(f) or (p) of EU Regulation 1069
- Food leftovers, kitchen waste and food scraps
- Pasta, pastes, cakes, pastries, soup, sauces
- Leaves, peelings and fruit and vegetable leftovers, potatoes
- Paper coffee filters and coffee grounds
- Teabags and tea leaves
- Paper tissues, napkins and kitchen roll

General requirements:

- Fresh matter, not rotting and not mouldy
- No non-fermentable matter such as wood, sand, stones, shells, soil, filter equipment, etc.
- Only packaging material in which the food was packaged
- Compostable disposables are generally prohibited
- The food waste may NOT consist only of meat or fish waste
- No meat or fish waste other than that prepared for consumption
- No chemical waste, residual waste or garden waste
- No products that are classified as hazardous or bear hazard symbols on the original packaging
- No animal carcasses or abattoir waste, no bones or bodies
- No mussel shells and no thick broth bones
- No frying fat or oil and no grease trap content
- No manure or other excrement

Deliveries in which more than 25% packaging material (i.e. plastic, cardboard, etc.) is present will be regarded as non-compliant deliveries.

Subject to an additional fee, a maximum of 3% foodstuffs in glass and/or cans may be allowed.

Removal under EURAL code 02 02 03 or 20 01 08

In case of non-conformity, the collector reserves the right to reject the load in question and/or to pass on any extra costs of collection and processing.
