

CONDITIONS FOR ACCEPTANCE

Combustible non-residential waste

DESCRIPTION

Any solid waste resulting from the operations of a commercial, industrial or institutional premise, which is not suitable for recycling and can be processed in an incinerator.

Permitted

Any non-recyclable but combustible waste from operations at non-residential premises. The dimensions must not exceed $30 \times 30 \times 60$ cm

If the dimensions are greater than 30 \times 30 \times 60 cm, this is referred to as bulky combustible non-residential waste.

- Office waste, canteen waste, packaging material, paper and cardboard: >95 v%
- Organic residues (food), cans and/or glass: <5 v%

Prohibited

- Substances causing odour nuisance
- Burnt waste
- Chemicals or other substances that may cause damage to human, animal or plant health, or harm to the soil
- Materials containing asbestos or suspect asbestos-containing materials
- Explosive waste, fireworks and flares
- Burning or smouldering waste or substances which, when in contact with water, release flammable gases and/or ignite
- Waste materials that are difficult to process because of hygienic, aesthetic and/or technical reasons, such as medical waste, agricultural foil, mattresses, car tyres, insulation material (fiberglass, mineral wool, polystyrene).
- Radioactive substances and substances emitting ionizing radiation and materials that have been exposed to such radiation and can be expected to emit such radiation
- Partially filled drums and closed drums, barrels, boxes and other packaging material whose contents cannot be directly inspected
- Pressurized cylinders, such as laughing gas canisters
- Food processing waste (swill), waste from meat and poultry or fish processing, carcasses, slaughterhouse waste and faeces
- Sand, soil, stones, concrete and rubble
- Liquid waste and pasty waste such as (partially) filled paint cans or sealant cartridges
- Dusty waste and waste causing dust nuisance
- Large, solid non-combustible materials
- Waste that can cause streak or wick formation, such as video tapes, film rolls and film waste
- Bundled materials, such as bales of paper, foil or plastics
- White and brown goods, such as refrigerators and other electrical apparatus
- Batteries and car batteries
