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CONDITIONS FOR ACCEPTANCE

Roofing waste

DESCRIPTION

Roofing waste (tar or bituminous roofing membranes) from demolition or renovation of roofs

Permitted

- Roofing waste (tarry or modified bitumen)
- Adhering contaminants such as insulation material, wood, roofing gravel, roof reeds, plaster, foil, aluminium roof trims, etc. <10 v%
- Specific weight >250 kg/m³

Tar-containing roofing membranes have been used until 1980. Bituminous roofing membranes have been used since 1975.

Tarry and bituminous roofing waste must be offered separately.

Prohibited

- Hazardous waste
- Construction and demolition waste
- Asbestos or suspect asbestos-containing materials
- Iron and steel profiles, strips, chains, etc.
- Commercial waste
- Mixing of tar-containing and bituminous roofing membranes
- Insulation materials, demolition waste, sand and/or soil, rubble from chimneys, roofing gravel >10 v%
- Specific weight <250 kg/m³
