# Tar-containing roofing membrane ""

## DESCRIPTION

Tar-containing roofing membrane from demolition or renovation of roofs

### Permitted

- Tar-containing roofing membrane
- Adhering contaminants such as insulation material, wood, roofing gravel, aluminium roofing strips, etc.
  <5 v%</li>

Tarred roofing membranes have been used until 1980 and must be offered separately from bituminous roofing membranes. Tar-containing roofing membranes can be recognised by the following properties: brittleness, shiny material, mostly adhered gravel, strong penetrating odour, released dust causes skin irritation.

### Prohibited

- Hazardous waste
- Construction and demolition waste
- Asbestos or suspect asbestos-containing materials
- Iron and steel profiles, strips, chains, etc.
- (Contaminated) soil
- Commercial waste
- Insulation materials, demolition waste, sand and/or soil, rubble from chimneys, roofing gravel >5 v%
