CONDITIONS FOR ACCEPTANCE Hollow glass: Packaging glass



DESCRIPTION

Hollow glass that has been used as packaging material, not contaminated with chemical substances or liquids, free from any other waste that is immediately suitable for recycling.

CONDITIONS

• If the **colour** does not meet the standards below, it is referred to as colour contamination. Renewi will then accept the cargo as coloured glass.

COLOUR	STANDARD
White	More than 95% white glass
Green	More than 90% green glass
Brown	More than 75% brown glass

- The maximum allowable level of packaging related contamination is 2.5% by weight
- The compactness of the material must satisfy the waste company's and/or glass recycler's acceptance requirements for sorting and must not exceed 650 kg/m³
- The container must be at least 80% full, and must be emptied at least once a month

Permitted

- Empty glass waste (hollow glass) that has been used as packaging material.
- Packaging related contamination: material that makes up a substantial part of the packaging, such as: labels, wrappers, capsules, seals, caps, lids, stoppers and other closures made of paper, plastics and metal and food remains.

Prohibited

- Flat glass including windows, wired glass, greenhouse glass, mirrors and car windscreens
- Leaded glass, such as television glass and crystal glass.
- Bulb glass, quartz glass, opal glass, ceramic painted glass.
- Heat-resistant glass, including heat-resistant laboratory glass, ovenproof dishes, hobs, glass from washing machine and microwave doors and glass pan lids
- Medical glass from hospitals, care homes, laboratories, etc.
- Ceramic, stone and porcelain (CSP) from objects such as pots, crockery, tiles and dishes.
- Paper, including newspapers, books and cardboard.
- Plastic, including plastic bottles, bags and disposal tableware.
- Metals, including ferrous and non-ferrous metals and bottle caps.
- Other contaminants, such as wood, textile and leather, sand, concrete, earth, mud and street refuse
- Chemical waste (SCW) / hazardous waste (SHW) including chemicals, blood, blood plasma, needles, labels with a skull, cross and/or fire
- Medical waste containing organic residues/fluids (SMW)
- Batteries and car batteries
